

The **Cognitive Neuroscience of Addictions Laboratory (CNALab)** in the McMaster Department of Psychiatry and Behavioural Neurosciences is currently recruiting undergraduate research assistants to join our lab.

The CNALab is located in the Peter Boris Centre for Addictions Research at St. Joseph's Healthcare West 5<sup>th</sup> Hospital. Our research examines the **cognitive and neural basis of addiction**, with current projects focusing on alcohol and tobacco abuse and their intersection with other psychiatric disorders (e.g., depression)

Research assistants in the CNALab contribute to all aspects of our projects, including recruiting participants, running experiment sessions, data entry/analysis, and preparing presentations and publications.
